Did You Know?

- ❁ Christmas, as we know it today, is a Victorian invention of the 1860s.
- ❁ Christmas wasn't declared a federal holiday in the United States until June 1860.
- Rudolph, "the most famous reindeer of all," was the product of Robert L. May's imagination in 1939. The copywriter wrote a poem about the reindeer to help lure customers into the Montgomery Ward department store.
- ❁ From 1659 to 1681, the celebration of Christmas was outlawed in Boston, and law-breakers were fined five shillings.
- ❁ The legend of Santa Claus can be traced back hundreds of years to a monk named St. Nicholas. It is believed he was born sometime around 280 A.D. in Patara near Myra in modern-day Turkey.
- ❁ Each year, 30-35 million real Christmas trees are sold in the United States.
